AHEPA Empire State District 6 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION YEAR 2026



The **AHEPA Scholarship Perpetual Fund, Inc.** has scholarship programs, which were established to promote, encourage, induce and advance education. The scholarship foundation will accept applications from **graduating high school seniors**, **College/University students**, and **students enrolled in vocational training programs**.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant is a member of a Sons of Pericles chapter in District Six and is in good standing prior to the application deadline date of May 4, 2026;

OR

The applicant is the **son** or **daughter** [or grandson or granddaughter] of a chapter member of AHEPA in District Six in good standing for 2025 and 2026;

OR

The applicant is the **son** or **daughter** [or grandson or granddaughter] of a deceased chapter member of AHEPA in District Six who was in good standing at least two years prior to the date of his death;

AND

The applicant **MUST PLAN ON ATTENDING OR BE REGISTERED** full time (minimum 12 college credits), at an accredited college or university during the current calendar year of the application or planning on attending or matriculated in a certificate program at an accredited vocational school. The applicant must not have been a previous recipient of this Scholarship Program.

AHEPA HS Scholarship and Saint Basil Academy Scholarship

- You must be a **high school senior**
- Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- Submit SAT/ACT Test (if required by the college you are planning on attending)
- Submit high school transcripts

AHEPA College/University Scholarship

- You must be a **full-time student (Freshman-Senior)**
- Minimum 12 semester hours at an accredited college or university
- Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- Submit your college transcripts

AHEPA HS Senior or Currently Attending a Vocational Training Program

- Certification from the school registrar acknowledging your full-time status
- Submit high school transcripts

FILING

Please **use one of the enclosed applications**. Your complete application must be filed to be considered. Please note that the application is PDF fillable. We prefer that you type the responses. **In addition, applications should be submitted in one e-mail.**

The applicant is responsible for the submission of all documents and completion of all sections of the application and sending the complete package by **E-MAIL NO LATER THAN MAY 4, 2026, to ahepascholarshiped6@gmail.com**. All information received will be kept confidential. No items will be returned.

TRANSCRIPTS

High school seniors must submit the most recent official complete high school transcript **AND SAT or ACT scores. If your school doesn't require an SAT/ACT please indicate on the application. All transcripts must be official and submitted as part of the complete application.** Applicants should provide the name of the college, university or vocational school to which they have been accepted or planning to attend.

College students must submit their transcripts from an accredited college or university. Transcripts must be official and **submitted as part of the complete application.**

ESSAY QUESTION (200-250 typed words)

Describe a Hellenic relative who has been inspirational to you. How does that person's Hellenic values relate to your academic or career ambitions? **The use of AI will disqualify your application.**

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

Applicants must include no more than 1 letter of recommendation (official letterhead only) i.e., the applicant's teachers, counselors, advisors, professors, etc. The reference letter should not be submitted by a relative to the applicant.
